## **Fly fishing morning at Tavistock Trout Fishery – Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> May.**

Here are some more details from the fishery:

At 10 am Mr Tim James (L2.C.C.A, G.A.I.C) a local fly fishing instructor from Tavistock will be talking about the art of fly fishing while running a casting demonstration for all spectators and novices. Those of you that have always wanted to visit the fishery or know more about fly fishing without actually taking part are invited to come along free of charge and watch. Tea/Coffee and lemonade/coke will be provided free of charge. Parents, pupils and staff that would like to have ago at fly fishing are invited to attend at a special rate of £10 per adult including tackle hire and inc first fish caught. Pupils that would like to have ago with a float rod on our junior lake are also welcome during this day at a special rate of £9 per child including tackle hire and first fish caught.
